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# An invitation to experience staying with another student from another culture

This is the first time Kagawa University is launching a mixed-dormitory whereby an international student and a Japanese student stay together in the same apartment.

We envisage students living together in the same apartment, can learn from one another, and can share the joys and problems faced in everyday life. We expect this experience to be a preparatory phase for students to equip themselves as they delve into the real world.

## ■Facilities

In each apartment, there is a common space that includes kitchen, dining space with table and cabinet, refrigerator, washing machine, microwave oven, shower room, toilet, and store room.



For private use, there are two individual bedrooms which are furnished with air conditioning, curtain, desk, chair, desk carpet, small cabinet with lock. Tenants need to buy their own futons. For more details, see the HP link. Depending on the situation, a student may be able to rent the whole apartment (that is, both the rooms). Those who wish to do so may contact us. All the apartments are non-smoking.

## ■Monthly Rental fees

- Room rental: 23,000 Yen for one room (46,000 Yen for two rooms)
- Car parking: 3,000 Yen for one car (only for those who apply)
- ※ Utility bills (electricity and water) are charged separately
- ※ All bills (room and utilities) should be paid on time through bank transfer as stipulated by Kagawa University.
- ※ Gas bills are to be shared by the tenants
- ※ Cleaning fees (after moving out): 13,000 Yen +tax is a one-time charge that is collected during the moving in.
- ※ Upon moving out, there shall be an inspection of the room. If the tatami mats, walls are damaged and in need of repair or replacement, the tenants shall be responsible for these charges
- ※ Insurance against fires etc., is mandatory (We shall advise according)

## ■Application

- Eligibility
  - Students who are able to communicate with room-mate.
  - 1. International students (about 33 persons)
  - 2. Japanese students (about 15 persons)
- Residence period
  - 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 - 28<sup>th</sup> March 2018
  - ※ Please note that even as we shall try to match the room mates as best as we can, sometimes the matching may not fully fulfill the wishes of the individual.
