

The Center for International Research and Cooperation plays a central role in supporting international research exchange activities and implementing strategies that conform to the university's internationalization policies. To contribute to the advancement of international academic exchange at Kagawa University, the Center is responsible for a wide range of activities including: (1) planning, developing, and implementing international joint research and global initiatives for SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals)










Access Map
