### Course Plan

One	Orientation and topic introduction (early explorers and expeditions)
Two	Vocabulary Building (reading and listening)
Three	Note taking basics (listening for numbers, dates, and periods of time)
Four	Group Discussions (leadership and leadership qualities)
Five	Express your ideas (student presentations – important life event)

Six	Topic introduction (ethics)
Seven	Vocabulary Building (reading and listening)
Eight	Note taking basics (listening for examples and pauses that splits ideas)
Nine	Group Discussions (common social and ethical issues)
Ten	Express your ideas (student presentations –making an ethical decision)





### **Lesson Flow**

1. Warm-up (open-ended questions about the topic)
2. Vocabulary (word matching, synonyms, and commonly used expressions)
3. Reading and listening (Short paragraphs and audio clips)
4. Comprehension Questions (video presentation, note taking activity and comprehension)
5. Small Group Discussion (sharing one's ideas)
