Temporary university closure to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19

The governor of Kagawa Prefecture has requested all universities in the prefecture to close based on the Act on Special Measures for COVID-19.

As such, <u>Kagawa University</u> (with the exception of the Faculty of Medicine and the <u>University Hospital</u>) will be temporarily closed from April 25 to May 6.

During this period, we ask everyone to <u>avoid going outside</u> unless absolutely necessary, and <u>strictly refrain from going back to your home prefectures</u>, <u>sightseeing</u>, <u>or travelling across prefectures</u>. We ask for your understanding and awareness that these measures are for the safety of yourselves and those around you, and act accordingly.
