Class Summary

- The class will have several listening activities, this will include conversations between two speakers and some monologues.
- The class will discuss different topics, brainstorm ideas and organize them accordingly.
- The class topics for speaking and listening will be similar in some ways, students will be listening to a recording before the speaking activities. New vocabulary and idioms will be introduced, and comprehension will be assessed.
- Relevant class materials will be sent to students for self-study and reviews. Students are encouraged to speak out their minds in the class.

Requirements

- There is no English level requirement.

Attainment Targets

- The objective is to help students acquire skills in listening, and to develop effective and functional speaking skills.
- By the end of the course students are expected to:
 - Have engaged in focused and selective listening like listening for details, key words and gist.
 - Effectively handle short conversational exchanges, use natural speech pattern and common clarification strategies.
 - Learn relevant vocabulary and expressions that will help them express their ideas better in different social contexts.

Assessment Criteria

- Informal assessment will be done throughout the course.
- Students will be asked to write short paragraphs from time to time.
- There will be short listening, speaking and vocabulary assessment in every new topic.
