

Confirmed Cases of COVID-19

We hereby report that one Kagawa University student tested positive for COVID-19 on November 26.

1. Individual(s) Tested Positive

Student (Age: 20s)

2. Infection Route

On Wednesday, November 25, an employee where the student works part-time tested positive for COVID-19 (the 135th confirmed case in Kagawa Prefecture). The Takamatsu City Health Center identified nine Kagawa University students working at the same part-time job to have been in close contact and at high risk of infection. Upon taking a PCR test, results showed that one student was positive.

3. Measures Taken by Kagawa University

In order to ensure the safety at Kagawa University, undergraduate students and graduate students will not be permitted to enter the campus of the faculty to which the student tested positive belongs from Friday, November 27 to Sunday, November 29, and all classes will be conducted online for the time being.

In response to this case, all Kagawa University students, staff and faculty are strongly asked to further take careful measures to prevent the risk of spreading infection (wearing a mask, washing your hands, maintaining social distance, etc.) and make sure the people around you do the same.

At Kagawa University, we will continue to be in contact with the organizations concerned, and make every effort to prevent the risk of infection.

With regards to this case, we ask for your understanding and consideration for protecting the privacy of the student.
