Guide to Kagawa University for International Students





Kagawa University has six faculties which offer courses in Education, Law, Economics, Medicine, Engineering and Design, and Agriculture. All faculties offer opportunities for further studies at the graduate level, including Management. There are about 6,300 students currently enrolled in the university, including an international student body of about 120.

Degree Seeking International Students

 Undergraduate Students (except Faculty of Education) Eligibility for privately-funded international students is as follows:

- Applicants must have residential qualifications (Student) or be expected to have the status, and must have successfully completed 12 years of school education or the equivalent. Those who are expected to graduate by March 31 of the year they are entering are also eligible.
- Those who have taken the "Examinations for Japanese University for International Students (EJU)."

Graduate Students

Admission procedures including qualification and examinations vary for each Graduate School. Eligibility is as follows:

Applicants must have residential qualifications (Student) or be expected to have the status, and must have successfully completed 16 years (for Master's) or 18 years (for Doctor's) of school education, or the equivalent in countries other than Japan. Those who are expected to graduate by March 31 of the year they are entering are also eligible.

Non-Degree Seeking International Students

Exchange Students

Students enrolled at universities or institutions can study at Kagawa University as auditors or special audit students, based on the academic agreements between their home universities and Kagawa University. Examination, admission and tuition fees for the auditors and the special audit students are exempted while they maintain enrollment at their home universities or institutions where they pay tuition fees. Credits earned at Kagawa University are transferable to their home universities and institutions (tuition exemption and credit transfer are not applicable for some partner universities and institutions). Interested students should consult their home university's International Office or other relevant offices at their Faculties and Graduate Schools.

Research Students

Students who wish to conduct specific research on a non-credit basis may enter Kagawa University as research students by obtaining approval from each Faculty or Graduate School. Eligibility is as follows:

Undergraduate Students Applicants must have successfully completed undergraduate education, or have scholastic ability equivalent or superior to such persons.

Graduate Students Applicants must have successfully completed a master's degree program or the equivalent.

Applicants must have successfully completed undergraduate education or the equivalent, and has been recognized by Kagawa University to be suitable as a research student.

Auditors of elective courses only

Students who wish to take classes at Kagawa University may by obtaining approval from each Faculty or Graduate School. Admission requirements vary according to each Faculty and Graduate School.

Tuition Fee Waiver and Scholarships

Students may apply for the Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho) scholarship prior to arriving in Japan. For further information, please contact the Japanese Embassy in your country.

Privately-funded students can apply for scholarships through the university, after their arrival in Japan. Associations such as Kagawa University and other private foundations provide the scholarships and set the application periods. As such, the required qualifications and the given stipends differ from one scholarship to another. For details, please inquire at the Educational Affairs Section of each Faculty or Graduate School after entering Kagawa University.

Graduate or undergraduate degree seeking students who are having difficulty in paying their tuition fees for financial reasons and who are recognized to be achieving excellent results in their academic work can apply to have full or half of their tuition fees waived (graduate students), and scholarship (undergraduate students).

In principle, the period of residence is as follows: 2 years for Kaminocho International Dormitory: 1 year for the other dormitories. In addition to the room rental fee. maintenance fees, cleaning fees, and utilities (electricity, water, gas, Wi-Fi etc) may be charged separately.

Private Housing

In general, students should visit a real estate agency to find an apartment by themselves.

Kagawa University Co-op may assist students who wish to live in private apartments near the university. Monthly rent varies from ¥20,000 to ¥60,000 depending on room

Once details have been settled between the landlord and the potential tenant, a rental contract is drawn up. When concluding a rental contract, a guarantor is usually needed. An international student in Kagawa can request Kagawa Prefecture International Exchange Association to be a guarantor when renting private housing. To qualify for this program, an international student first needs to have General Housing Compensation Insurance.
