## Period/Area of Restriction

Period : From March 13, 2020 to March 31, 2020

Area: The Global Café (the Student Lounge and the Classroom)

## **Preventive Measures**

- Permission to enter the Global Cafe is limited to those who are affiliated to Kagawa University
- For those who are permitted to enter, the facilities are limited for use as follows:
  - (1) Opening hours are from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM
  - 2 No food and/or drinks are allowed in the Student Lounge
  - ③ No group meetings are allowed
  - (4) The Classroom is closed
  - (5) When entering the Global Café, please be aware of the followings:
    - If you are unwell with symptoms including fever, cough, difficulty breathing, and/or any other bad health condition, please refrain from entering the Global Cafe.
    - When entering, disinfect your hands with the hand sanitizer located at the entrance.
    - Wear a mask in the Student Lounge. Please note that the staff will always wear a mask.
- Maintain a distance of at least 1 meter from other users and avoid close contact. (Please note that we have limited the number of seats for this reason).
  - We open windows and entrances regularly to ventilate the Student Lounge. We recommend bringing some cold protectors or putting on clothes that will keep you warm in the lounge.
