Class Summary

- The students will have to read different passages and essays. They will learn to analyse the contents of different paragraphs and essays.
- The reading passages will be provided ahead for the students to read in advance. In class, we will be breaking the passages down to understand it better before we do a group writing activity.
- In writing class, samples will be provided as a reference and students will learn paraphrasing, paragraphing and structuring.

Requirements

- There is no English level requirement.

Attainment Targets

- The objective is to build confidence and allow learners to practice English language in the areas of reading and writing.
- By the end of the course students are expected to:
 - Have read several reading passages and essays that will help in vocabulary development, comprehension and idea organization.
 - Have learned how to use paragraphs and other structural conventions for different essays.
 - Write simple paragraphs based on a given essay topic, this will include skills in structuring, comparing and contrasting ideas.

Assessment Criteria

- Informal assessment will be done throughout the course.
- Students will be asked to write short paragraphs from time to time.
