Special Libraries

► Kambara Library

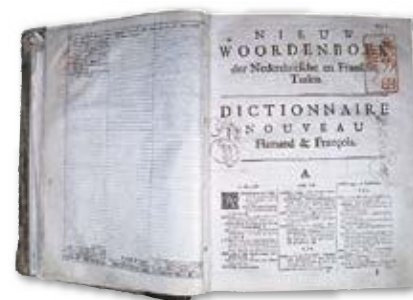
This is the library of 12,000 items in 16,560 volumes (15,890 Japanese and Chinese books and 670 foreign books) other archival materials collected by Mr. Jinzo Kambara, the first president of the former Kagawa University, and donated by his breaved family. The library contains books and materials published or written during the period from the late Edo era to the mid Meiji era, and many of them reflect the process of adopting Western culture and the cultural and social trends of the times. Among them, *Iroha* (Korean edition), *Arashimujomonogatari* (Saikaku's version), and F. Halma's *Dutch-French Dictionary* (the source volume of H. Doeff's Dutch-Japanese Dictionary) are extremely rare. The collection also contains such visual materials as Nishikie prints (Japanese color prints) and Nishikie newspapers. The classified catalogue of the library and a supplement were published in February, 1964 and in March, 1994 repectively.

▶ Sawaragi Library

This is the library of 1,826 books from Mr. Hachiro Sawaregi's collection. The main body of the library is foreign books on the German law.

▶ Arima Library

This is the library of 1,793 books from Mr. Chuzaburo Arima's collection in the field of the Japanese law. The library contains rare and valuable books.
