### Course Overview

The class will focus on **vocabulary building** and English conversation practice to **increase confidence** and **fluency** in spoken English. The core of each class will be **group discussions** based on a wide variety of practical everyday themes.

### Course Goals

To give students the opportunity to practice as much spoken English as possible and provide them with the skills necessary to **express their opinion** more freely on a wide variety of **everyday topics**.

### Course Content

**Group discussions** will be held each week based on a single topic. Classes will be conducted in English, but students will be given a worksheet with **useful words, phrases, and idioms** to help them discuss each theme. After **talking in small groups** about each question, students will be encouraged to share what they discussed with the whole class. Any **necessary feedback or advice** will be given before starting the next question. Each topic is predicted to take 2-3 weeks to complete.
