The Tuition Adjustments for Students Enrolling in Academic Year 2027 and Beyond

1. Purpose of The Tuition Adjustments

- Kagawa university recognizes its role in the region as a center of knowledge and expertise comprising a diverse range of academic fields, and seeks to be a distinctive and competitive student-centered university with strong ties to the community. We are committed to fostering the development of creative and compassionate professionals and researchers through its world-class education and research opportunities, in addition to serving as a leader in the local community and working towards the realization of a symbiotic society.
- Since becoming a national university corporation, Kagawa University has continued its efforts to secure financial resources, including actively seeking external funding, amid reductions in operating grants. However, our financial situation has become increasingly difficult due to factors such as the recent sharp rise in prices. Even under these circumstances, to fulfill the university's mission in the years ahead, we must not only ensure a high-quality learning environment for every student from enrollment through graduation, but also further improve and develop the quality of education to meet the evolving needs of society. For these reasons, although tuition fees have remained unchanged for 22 years since academic year (AY) 2005, we have decided on the tuition adjustment for students enrolling in AY2027 and beyond, as outlined in "2. Students Covered, Revised Tuition Fees, and Effective Dates" on the following page.
- To ensure that students do not lose educational opportunities for financial reasons as a result of the tuition adjustment, we will also consider additional financial support measures.
- We will make it our top priority to further enhance the quality of the educational environment so that students can study with peace of mind and enjoy a fulfilling university life.

2. Students Covered, Revised Tuition Fees, and Effective Dates

3. Enhancing Student Support

(1) Enhancement of Financial Support

Kagawa University will expand its own financial aid programs to ensure that no student loses the opportunity to pursue higher education for financial reasons.

- Under the New Higher Education Support System (including tuition and fee waivers for students from households with three or more dependent children), the University will provide waivers equivalent to the tuition increase to ensure that students' out of pocket tuition pay me not increase.
- The University will expand the short-term loan program for Kagawa University students facing financial hardship due to emergency or unexpected expenses.

In addition, using its own funds, the university will expand its interest subsidy program for students whose parents or guardians have taken out education loans from private financial institutions (excluding consumer finance companies) or the Japan Finance Corporation. Through this program, the university covers part of the interest.

The University will also enhance student support programs, including incentives for high-achieving students and support for study abroad, conference presentations, and job hunting.

Furthermore, the University will make greater use of the Teaching Assistant (TA) program to improve the working conditions of graduate students and enhance the quality of university education.

①Under the New Higher Education Support System (including tuition and fee waivers for students from households with three or more dependent children), the University will provide waivers equivalent to the tuition increase to ensure that students' out of pocket tuition pay me not increase.

→The amount of the tuition fee to be paid by students receiving support under the New Higher Education Support System will remain unchanged.

②The University will expand the short-term loan program for Kagawa University students facing financial hardship due to emergency or unexpected expenses.

→The maximum loan amount per academic year will be increased.

③The university will expand its interest subsidy program for students whose parents or guardians have taken out education loans from private financial institutions (excluding consumer finance companies) or the Japan Finance Corporation.

→The University will increase the maximum principal amount eligible for benefits and raise the maximum benefit amount.

④The University will also enhance student support programs, including incentives for high-achieving students and support for study abroad, conference presentations, and job hunting.

→The University will expand support for student-led initiatives through various support programs.

⑤Further Utilization of the Teaching Assistant (TA) program

→The University will expand the Teaching Assistant (TA) program in undergraduate courses to enhance learning support for undergraduate students while improving support and opportunities for graduate students.

(2) Enhancing the Learning Support Environment

The University will use the additional revenue generated by the tuition adjustment, together with other available resources, to further improve and expand the learning support environment. In particular, to help students take the initiative in their learning and develop the practical skills and creativity required by society, we will improve the quality of the learning support environment by providing learning support using AI and digital technologies, strengthening information education and practical education in digital transformation (DX), and expanding practical education in cooperation with the local community.

Enhancing Learning Support (Expanding learning tools and software, improving learning support systems, strengthening the TA program, and expanding international exchange activities, etc.)	1.8
Improving the Learning Environment (Enhancing ICT infrastructure in lecture halls and other spaces; upgrading equipment for student practical training, etc.)	3.8
Enhancing Student Life Support Services (Enhancing counseling services, support for student-led activities, and support for job hunting, etc.)	0.5
Improving the Campus Environment (Renovating the Health Center and extracurricular activity facilities, and systematically replacing air-conditioning systems to address global warming, etc.)	6.2
