Restrictions on University Entry due to COVID-19

Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed at Kagawa University, we will be reinforcing our on-campus measures against the spread of infection as follows. In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we ask each and every student to stay alert, take caution and act accordingly.

Campus Entry Restrictions due to COVID-19

1. Restricted Areas

Saiwai-cho Campus, Hayashi-cho Campus, Miki-cho (Agriculture) Campus *Miki-cho (Medicine) Campus is not subject to the following restriction.

2. Duration

December 17 (Thursday) – December 20 (Sunday), 2020

3. Notes

- (1) All students are prohibited to enter into the restricted areas (campuses).
- (2) All classes conducted at the restricted areas will be conducted online.
- (3) Alternative measures are available to students who are not able to join classes online due to these restrictions. Those who require these arrangements should contact their respective academic affairs section of their faculty.
- (4) From December 21 (Monday), classes will be conducted online in principle. Classes that require face-to-face meetings will be conducted inperson upon ensuring preventive measures against infection. If the situation of infection changes, new instructions are likely to be announced. Be sure to check your email for the newest information.

Restrictions on Extra-Curricular Activities and Caution on Student Life

1. Extra-Curricular Activities

Extra-curricular activities (contests, events, etc.) both on-campus and offcampus may not be held for the time being.

2. Caution on Student Life

- (1) If you have a fever or other symptoms of a cold, refrain from going outdoors.
 - If the symptoms continue, call a nearby medical facility or call the Kagawa Prefecture Coronavirus Call Center (0570-087-550).
- (2) Follow the basics of disease prevention including avoiding the "3 Cs", maintaining social distance between others, wearing a mask, washing your hands.
- (3) Eating out in a group, especially meals involving alcohol, will not be permitted for the time being. Refrain from activities that involve using a loud voice (speaking loudly at a restaurant, karaoke, shouting at sport events, etc.).
- (4) Do not work at part-time jobs that lack preventive measures such as not requiring you to wear a mask when serving a customer.
