MULTICULTURAL EXCHANGE ACTIVITIES

As we move toward a new academic year, the autumn/winter semester has hosted an exciting array of events for all students at Kagawa University. The autumn semester began with "Meet and greet with Luke-sensei and Wu-sensei" and concluded with the A-Capella singing circle performing at the Global Café. Presentation and Haiku Contests were held, and international students from around the world shared their home cultures through talks and interactions. Countries represented by these talks were Brunei, China, Malawi, Pakistan, Taiwan, Vietnam, Thailand and South Korea. An end of year party was held and organised by the Inter-Cultural Exchange Society (ICES).

Various language and cultural classes were offered to students of all levels, from conversational English to ancient Egypt's pyramids and mummies. Also, teachers and students from Munkkiniemen yhteiskoulu high school visited from Finland to learn about Japan and share information about Finnish education and culture. The class "Japanese Current Affairs a" with the Global Café organised a field trip to Ritsurin Garden and a hiking trip to Yashima for international students to gain insight into local Kagawa culture.

Above all, the Global Café offered a hub of intercultural exchange as students from Japan and around the world visited the social space and enjoyed opportunities to talk with each other. The Global Café offers vast chances for students to take extra language and culture classes, practice their language skills and make lifelong friends from the international community.

PRESENTATION CONTEST

The 10th annual English Presentation Contest took on December 15th, at the Olive Square Multipurpose Hall. The topic of the presentation was "What is a Good Job?" 23 students participated in the contest, offering unique perspectives on the topic. The contest was divided into two groups: 'open level' for all and 'restricted level' for undergraduates with a TOEIC score of 550 or lower. The open level contest was won by Yuki Taira, a 1st year Medicine student who spoke about 'the recipe for a good job', and the restricted level contest was won by 1st year Education student Yuya Okazaki who spoke about 'a lasting memory' of volunteer work.
