Kagawa University (KU) is collaborating with Chiang Mai University, Thailand (CMU) and National Chiayi University, Taiwan (NCYU) to organize the 1st Trilateral Symposium on SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals).

As a primer to the actual symposium planned for 2022, we (KU, CMU, NCYU) are organizing a series of online Symposium Sessions to jump start the event.

One of the aims of the Trilateral Symposium is to foster rapport and international exchange among students from the three universities. To facilitate this, a Student Session is organized.

This is an exciting and excellent opportunity to learn new things and to make new friends with fellow students from CMU and NCYU.

We strongly urge students from KU to apply to join the Student Session. Refer to the following for more information.

1. Team presentation

Students from KU, CMU, NCYU shall be assigned to one of five teams. Each team shall consist of a mixture or combination of students from all three universities. Depending on the number of successful applicants, teams may have a minimum number of 9 students (3+3+3) to a maximum number of 15 students (5+5+5). Supported by a faculty member, students shall collaborate and work with team members to select a theme, prepare slides and get ready for presentation.

2. Schedule

There will be three sub-sessions within the Student Session. Students should make sure they will be able to participate in all the three sub-sessions. Students are required to prepare materials and improve the PPT slides before and after Sub-session 2. If necessary, students may decide and agree to get together for additional online discussions (on top of the official Sub-session 2)
